The Sixth Street Community Guides provide a friendly and welcoming presence in the public realm of San Francisco's Sixth Street community. The Community Guides provide wayfinding and customer service to visitors while supporting social service providers, police and other City agencies, residents, workers, merchants and property owners in creating a clean, safe and welcoming Sixth Street neighborhood.

The Sixth Street Community Guides:

- Act as “eyes and ears” for the community
- Assist pedestrians with directions and information
- Help connect individuals in need of assistance to social service providers
- Add a uniformed presence to prevent undesirable behavior
- Maintain open communication with City agencies
- Provide merchant and community outreach

Community Guides is a community-based program in partnership with social service providers, safety agencies, and neighborhood organizations. This service is provided by the Central Market Community Benefit District through a contract with the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency.
